dence on Deer Walk. It was also advised that the suspect(s) in this case, two small children, a two-year-old male and four-year-old female, were found walking down the street barely clothed earlier on this date, and were at a neighbor's house who had taken them in from the cold.

Investigators then went to the other residence where the suspect(s) were residing. During the investigation, investigators located chemicals and items used to manufacture methamphetamine, including ammonia in an unapproved cylinder.

At this time, the mother of the children, Alicia Johns, W/F, 24, was placed under arrest charged with endangering a child. The items used in the manufacture of methamphetamine are still being investigated with other arrests probable in the offense. Investigators contacted child protective services who responded and removed the children from the residence.

\* On Friday, January 23,

2009, Henderson County Drug Enforcement Unit Investigator Ronny Halbert conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in Seven Points, Texas. Investigator Halbert obtained consent to search the vehicle and located a quantity of methamphetamine inside the vehicle.

The driver of the vehicle Moreno, Stephen, W/M, 36, was arrested and transported to Henderson County Justice Center charged with Possession of Controlled Substance Pgl. <1 gram. Moreno posted a \$10,500.00 bond set by Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 4 Sue Tarrant.

\* On January 26, 2009, Henderson County Drug Enforcement Investigators Jody Miller and Ronny Halbert went to the home of Terry Bevell on Robert Drive in the city of Seven Points, Texas, to serve arrest warrants on Terry Bevell, W/M, 45, who was wanted on outstanding warrants out of Gun Barrel City, Texas. Upon arrival to the residence, investigators took Bevell into custody for the outstanding warrants.

While at the residence, investigators obtained consent from Terry Bevell to search the residence for narcotics.

Bevell had been under investigation by the Henderson County Drug Enforcement Unit for manufacturing and distribution of methamphetamine around the Cedar Creek Lake area.

During a search of the residence, investigators located an unapproved cylinder containing anhydrous ammonia which is a precursor in the manufacture of methamphetamine.

Investigators also located a quantity of methamphetamine at the residence. Both Terry Bevell and Marnette Adams, W/F, 20, who was staying at the residence with Bevell, were transported to the Henderson County Jail. Bevell was charged with possession of controlled substance PG1 under 1 gram and possession / transport anhydrous ammonia and Marnette Adams was charged with possession of controlled substance PG1 under 1 gram.

Investigators were assisted in the investigation at the Bevell residence by Henderson County Drug Enforcement Investigator Kenneth Collard and Henderson County Sheriff's Department Deputy Kyle Pochobradsky.

## Do I need a mammogram?

Breast cancer is currently the second most common cause of cancer death among women. It is estimated that one in every seven women will develop breast cancer by age eighty-five. Of those who develop breast cancer, approximately one-half will die. Fortunately, there are effective screening strategies that are available for early detection.

Early detection is imperative to prevent and diagnose breast cancer. In fact, mammograms are able to detect lesions two years before patients can feel them.

Women should begin having yearly screening mammograms at age 40 in combination with a clinic performed breast exam. Patients that have a first degree relative (mother or sister) with breast cancer should begin having a breast exam performed by their primary care provider every six months and an annual mammogram starting ten years prior to the age of the youngest family member that had breast cancer (but not earlier than age 25 and not later than age 40).

Young women should begin having a clinic based breast exam by their primary care providers by age twenty. Also, at this time they should start doing monthly self-breast exams. Self-exams can be performed anytime during the month. You should raise one arm and use the finger pads of your second, third and fourth fingers to feel around your breast in small circles, examining each point. It is important to check under your arms and to examine the nipple. All women should be aware of any changes in their breasts.

In summary, annual well-woman exams, self-breast exams and patient education are the key to early detection of breast cancer.
